Duration of the Programme

Examinations

- National examinations take place three times a year
- Candidates require a term mark that will be combined with the examination mark in order to pass
- The pass mark is minimum 40% per subject

National N Diploma

Candidates must comply with the following minimum requirements in order to obtain a National N Diploma:

- A National N6 Certificate in either Electrical,
 Mechanical or Civil Engineering with a minimum of twelve (12) advanced instructional offerings in each of the Grades N4, N5 and N6
- Documentary proof of at least two years applicable experience in business and industry. This should facilitate the practical implementation of any two (2) of the N6 subjects relevant to the candidate's vocational training.
- A National N Diploma is evaluated as a three (3) year tertiary qualification
